

Stillgarden Distillery COVID 19 Safety Plan

1. Maximum number of single participants is **15**
2. People who have arrived in a group from the same household will be seated together.
3. If you show any symptoms will be asked along with guests you arrived with to immediately leave and seek medical assistance.
4. Before arrival we will have designated all seating keeping as many people from the same household and who are known to each other in the same area.
5. Upon arrival your temperature will be taken outside the premises before entry.
6. Once you show no signs of illness you will be greeted and shown your designated seating.
7. Once seated , at your area which will have just been fully decontaminated, you will find glass in front and at either side of you, for your safety and for others.
8. Gloves, masks and hand sanitizer will be provided.
9. Before the session starts a representative on site will run through safety protocols with you, to maximise safety for yourself and for others.
10. Each area will be sanitized after use, this includes the lab bathrooms, distilling academy, botanical wall and anything other area or object that comes into human contact.

Guidelines for guests

Consider the following advice on how to protect yourself and others from COVID-19 infection.

1. Wash hands properly and regularly.
2. Before and after eating or drinking.
3. After going to the toilet, nose blowing, sneezing or coughing.
4. Whenever hands become visibly dirty.
5. Cover mouth when coughing and sneezing.
6. Cover nose and mouth with disposable tissues – if you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your arm or sleeve (not hand)
7. Place used tissues into a sealed bin – wash your hands
8. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean
